

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ADOPT ORDINANCE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of County Commissioners of Okaloosa County, Florida, on February 20, 2024, at 8:30 A.M., or soon thereafter, at the County Commission Meeting Room located at the Okaloosa County Administrative Building located at 1250 N. Eglin Parkway, Shalimar, Florida 32579 will hold a public hearing to consider adopting an ordinance, the title and substance of said proposed ordinance being:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OKALOOSA COUNTY, FLORIDA CREATING THE LAKE CLYDE MAINTENANCE DREDGING ASSESSMENT MUNICIPAL SERVICES BENEFIT UNIT; MAKING VARIOUS LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITIONS; SETTING FORTH THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION PROCEDURES; PROVIDING FOR THE INITIAL AND FINAL ASSESSMENT RESOLUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT ROLL; PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF A LIEN; AUTHORIZATION OF ALTERNATIVE METHODS OF COLLECTION; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

If any person decides to appeal any decision made with respect to any matter considered at this hearing, such person will need a record of the proceeding and may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceeding is made which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.
