Department News –

- Public Safety wanted to me share this aerial for progress being made at the 911 Emergency Operations Center.

- A draft of the Erosion Control Line maps for Destin and Okaloosa Island are available at Destin City Hall, the Okaloosa County Tourist Development Council and in the County Commission office in Fort Walton. Florida Department of Environmental Protection Workshops will be held later this month.

- New bus fares for the WAVE are \$1.00, reduced fares will be \$.25 and transfers for the WAVE will be \$.25. Disabled citizens are eligible for the reduced fare with valid Okaloosa County Transit Reduced Fare ID card. Medicare (not Medicaid) cards will still be accepted as the proof of eligibility for reduced fair.

- In 2008 the Okaloosa County Purchasing Department, in cooperation with Eglin officials, implemented a system to facilitate Eglin with a list of construction projects and purchase orders. Okaloosa County is the only county who has successfully extended a hand to a neighboring military base in this fashion, where the deliverables are the property of Eglin. The project was so successful, that the Purchasing Department and their Eglin partners in the Civil Engineering Group recently briefed several officials from Washington DC, and the guidelines developed by the Purchasing Department and Eglin Air Force Base will become guidelines for a national plan.

- Moment in History... Provided in part by the Baker Block Museum and Heritage Book of Okaloosa County. It's a new year and I'm feeling reminiscent... Do you remember when coke was a nickel and shoes for children were 69 cents? You got both shoes for that too! Imagine what salaries were!
