

MOVING CONTRACTOR

“House Moving Contractor” means any person who is qualified to plan, permit, deconstruct, prepare and remove an existing structure from one permanent site and transport it on temporary supports to another site for permanent installation.

Okaloosa County requires applicants for State Registered and Local Specialty Licenses to appear before the appropriate competency board for approval prior to testing.

Applicants are required to take the Business and Law examination and pass with a score of 75% or above.

Fees paid to Okaloosa County: \$25 Board Processing Fee
\$50 Sponsor Fee (per registration)
\$35 State Package Review Fee

Additional fees to the testing agency will also apply.

In order to take the examination, you must be twenty-two (22) years of age or older.
