

# **RESIDENTIAL POOL/SPA CONTRACTOR**

**“Residential Pool/Spa Contractor”** means a contractor whose scope of work involves, but is not limited to, the construction, repair and servicing of any residential swimming pool or hot tub or spa, regardless of use, including the repair or replacement of existing equipment or the installation of new equipment, as necessary. The scope of work includes layout, excavation, operation of construction pumps for dewatering purposes, steelwork, installation of light niches, construction of floors, guniting, fibreglassing, installation of tile and coping, installation of all perimeter and filter piping, installation of all filter equipment and chemical feeders of any type, plastering of the interior, construction of decks, installation of housing for pool equipment, and installation of package pool heaters and also includes the scope of work of a swimming pool/spa servicing contractor. However, the scope of work does not include direct connections to a sanitary sewer system or to potable water lines. The installation, construction, modification, or replacement of equipment permanently attached to and associated with the pool or spa for the purpose of water treatment or cleaning of the pool or spa requires licensure; however, the usage of equipment for the purposes of water treatment or cleaning shall not require licensure unless the usage involves construction, modification, or replacement of equipment. Water treatment that does not require equipment does not require a license. In addition, a license shall not be required for the cleaning of the pool or spa in any way that does not affect the structural integrity of the pool or spa or its associated equipment.

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**Okaloosa County requires applicants for State Registered and Local Specialty Licenses to appear before the appropriate competency board for approval prior to testing.**

Applicants are required to take the trade exam **PLUS** the Business and Law examination and pass with a score of 75% or above on both examinations.

Fees paid to Okaloosa County: \$25 Board Processing Fee  
\$50 Sponsor Fee (per registration)  
\$35 State Package Review Fee

Additional fees to the testing agency will also apply.

**In order to take the examination, you must be twenty-two (22) years of age or older.**
