



## Temporary/Full Electrical Power Request

Temporary Full Electrical Power Request is for the purpose of checking out circuits and equipment. The Electrical Contractor, or Homeowner acting as the electrical contractor, do hereby acknowledge by their signature below that they understand and accept that this will be temporary power for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days unless extended by this department.

# Granting of temporary power does not authorize occupancy of the premises.

A certificate of occupancy can only be issued after an approved final inspection has been performed and all checklist items are completed.

The general/building/residential contractor or the electrical contractor, are the only persons authorized to call our office to schedule the early power inspection on residential jobs. Only the electrical contractor can call for commercial projects.

**FEE: \$50.00 for residential and \$75.00 for commercial per inspection.**
