

Beasley Park will Temporarily Close

Beasley Park on Okaloosa Island is scheduled to be closed to the public for renovations from January 16 through February 1, 2007. Walkways will be repainted and boards replaced for overall scheduled restoration, to include parking areas.

During this time, visitors and residents can enjoy Marler Park for Soundside access, which includes boat ramps, or for Gulf access, enjoy the Boardwalk on Okaloosa Island.

Seven main beach access-ways along Santa Rosa Boulevard, on Okaloosa Island will also be available by January 10. Currently, numbers one, two, three and seven are open for your enjoyment. Restrooms, picnic areas and parking are available.
