

New Security Entrance at Crestview Courthouse

Visitors entering the Crestview Courthouse will now pass through a security checkpoint, equipped with metal detectors. Personal items will be scanned, as well. Additionally, all visitors will be required to enter the Courthouse at the entrance facing Highway 90. These new security measures are for the protection of all the citizens of Okaloosa County.
