Heritage Museum to Hosts a Class in the Ancient Art of Tatting in July

Visit the Heritage Museum of Northwest Florida (HMNF), for a lesson in the ancient art of tatting – traditional lace making – on July 17, 18, 24 and 25 from 9:30 - 11:30 a.m. Tatting produces intricate lace by the knotting of fine thread held on a small shuttle. (A shuttle is a device used in weaving thread.)

This four-part class is part of the HMNF's popular and ongoing Heritage Craft Series, intended to keep traditional handcrafts alive. Cost is \$35, or \$30 HMNF members, and includes all materials. Pre-registration is required.
