## **Okaloosa County Commission to hold Executive Session**

The Okaloosa County Commission will conduct an Executive Session at 3 p.m. on Tuesday, March 31, 2009 in the County Commission Meeting Room on the third floor of the Water & Sewer Building to discuss ongoing litigation.

After the meeting is convened the Board will go into closed session pursuant to Section 286.011(8), Florida Statutes. The subject matter of the executive session is the pending litigation of Cornerstone Construction and Development, Inc. v. Okaloosa County. The discussions in this session shall be confined to settlement negotiations and/or strategy relating to litigation expenditures. The session will be recorded by a certified court reporter. The meeting will last approximately 1 hour and will be attended by Commissioners Don Amunds, James Campbell, Wayne Harris, John Jannazo and Bill Roberts; County Administrator James Curry; County Attorney John Dowd; and Special Counsel, Greg Stewart, Esq.

Following the closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session in the Board Chambers so that the Chair may announce the termination of the executive session.
