Okaloosa County Water and Sewer Department is recognizing March 16-20, 2009 as “Fix a Leak” Week, along with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). During the week EPA WaterSense, is encouraging individuals to improve the water efficiency in their homes by checking for and fixing leaks. Nationwide the amount of water leaked from U.S. homes each year could exceed more than 1 trillion gallons – equivalent to the annual water use of Los Angeles, Chicago and Miami combined.
