## **Public Hearing Scheduled for Beach Restoration MSBU Final Assessments *Okaloosa Island & Destin Assessments Available for Public Review***

The Board of County Commissioners will hold a Public Hearing on the Municipal Services Benefit Unit (MSBU), at the **August 18** County Commission meeting, at 6:00 p.m. The meeting is scheduled on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor conference room of the Water and Sewer Building, 1804 Lewis Turner Boulevard, in Fort Walton Beach. **Assessment rolls for the Okaloosa County Beach Restoration Project MSBU can be reviewed at the following locations prior to the Public Hearing:** Okaloosa County Administrator's office, Suite 400 of the Water and Sewer Building, Tourist Development Council on Okaloosa Island, Emerald Coast Conference Center, 1250 Miracle Strip Pkwy SE and Destin City Hall, 4200 Indian Bayou Trail in Destin.

Under the ordinance creating the MSBU for Beach Renourishment, an initial assessment resolution is adopted and a public hearing for final assessment. Previously on June 16, 2009, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the Initial Assessment Resolution, and this hearing is for consideration of the Final Assessment Resolution.
