Okaloosa County Parks Turn Water Off

Okaloosa County Resources Department will turn off the water in Baker Ball Park, Cotton Bridge Park on Highway 4, and Shoal River Bridge Park on Highway 85, beginning tonight, February 3. Park restrooms will reopen during daytime hours.

Additionally, beach accessways 1, 2, 3 and 7 will be closed, along with Beasley Park, Wednesday and Thursday evenings, February 4th and 5th. Water will be shut off during evening hours.
