Recreational Pond Management Workshop March 23 *Homeowner Associations and Citizens Encouraged to Attend FREE Workshop*

The Okaloosa County Extension office is offering a Recreational Pond Management Workshop at the Extension office in Crestview on **March 23, 2009** from **6:00 to 8:00 p.m.** The **FREE** workshop will be held at the **Walthall Agricultural Center** at 5479 Old Bethel Road in Crestview.

Fishery specialists from the University of Florida will address how and what to stock, fertilizing, liming and managing for the fish you want. Aquatic Weed Specialist will be on hand to identify weeds and make recommendations for control. Attendees are encouraged to bring fresh samples of weed control problems.
