

Okaloosa County News Release

Road Update

Although some roads have been opened, they remain treacherous and should be driven with extreme caution:

Fairchild Road is now **OPEN** to thru traffic.

Ludlum Road is now **OPEN** to thru traffic, with barricades blocking damaged areas.

Millside Road is now **OPEN** to thru traffic.

Helms Farm Road is now **OPEN (1 lane only)** to thru traffic.

Sherman Kennedy Road is now open **Old River Road** north of Baker is **closed** at Horse Creek due to flooding. Closure extends from Hwy 2 on the north side of the creek to James Peaden Road on the south side. James Peaden Road can be used as a detour from Hwy 2 to access the south side of the creek.

North of Holt: Looney Road at Boggy Hollow Bridge **CLOSED** from C180 to Tommie Steele Road due to water over the bridge. Also **Peaden Bridge Road** at Peaden Bridge is **CLOSED** due to water over the bridge.

Lower Dead Fall Bridge on Old River Road north of Baker is **CLOSED** due to water over the bridge. The extends from Lee Cook Road to the north to Holloway Road to the south. Detour consists of Holloway Road to Vinson Ray Road to Hwy 190 to Shockley Springs Road back to Old River Road. The bridge will remain closed until a complete inspection is conducted. Please plan accordingly.

Lee Cook Road north of Baker is **CLOSED** at Polley Creek, just east of Hwy 189, due to pipe failure. The closure extends from Hwy 189 to Curtis Madden Road. Detour is from Curtis Madden Road to Old River Road to Hwy 2 (west to Hwy 189, east to Hwy 8) on the east side of the closure. Please plan accordingly.

Flooding of Horse Creek north of Baker has caused the closure of two roads at the creek crossings: **W. Kelly Road & Horse Creek Road**. W. Kelly Road will detour down L.G. Russell Road to the west and Rockhill Road to the east. Horse Creek Road will only require detour to the east, to Rockhill Road.

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
