Weather Warning

Update on Road Openings/Closings in North Okaloosa County ***Sandbags available***

Several Roads remain closed or awaiting inspection in the north part of Okaloosa County. More rain is expected starting Tuesday, and residents are urged to continue to use caution. Sandbags are available at the following locations and fire department personnel are available to assist in sandbagging:

Baker: Old Baker fire station and EMS Station 5 on Monroe St.
Crestview: Fire Station on P.J. Adams (next to 911/dispatch)
North Okaloosa County Public Works yard, supply section, 1759 S. Ferdon Blvd
Laurel Hill: Almarante Fire Station 3710 Old California Rd.

The bridge is out at Lake Ella and there is water over the bridge on Old Dorcas Road, also closed. Old Antioch Road is open at this time; however there is no through traffic. Ludlum and Steel Mill Road, south of Highway 85 is now open with only one lane in some areas. Ludlum Road north of Highway 85 is closed. The following roads remain closed in North Okaloosa County:

Fairchild Road - Dirt portion (no through traffic)
Hwy. 393 at Little Pond Creek, Big Pond Creek, Shoal River Bridge
Hwy. 85 at Southern Comfort Drive
Jim Strickland Road
Lake Ella Road (Bridge is out)
Ludlam Road at State Line & north of Hwy. 85
Mill Side-Doc Steele Bridge
Old Dorcas Road / off Hwy. 393
Old Ebenezer Road in Laurel Hill
Turkey Track Road at Lake Ella
TE Rogers, bridge under water
Thomas Road in Laurel Hill
