### H1N1 Vaccine Available for More Vaccine available for caregivers of infants, young adults

OKALOOSA COUNTY – After assessing Okaloosa County’s first day of H1N1 vaccination clinics, Health Department Director, Dr. Karen Chapman, M.D., has made the decision to offer the vaccine to additional high-risk populations.

Starting November 3, 2009, **parents/caregivers of children who are less than 6 months old, children/young adults through the age of 24, and pregnant women** can come to the Health Department locations in Ft Walton Beach and in Crestview for an H1N1 vaccination.
