Weather Warning

Okaloosa County is Under Severe Weather Watch

Okaloosa County is under flash flood warning and tornado watch. We will continue to monitor the storm and provide road updates throughout the day. Road openings/closings can be accessed from the home page at www.okaloosaf.com.

Okaloosa County continues to urge residents and visitors in Okaloosa County to use caution on area roadways as heavy rainfall has caused significant road flooding particularly in the northern areas of the county.

- **“Turn Around, Don’t Drown** – avoid flooded areas & roadways
- Watch for fallen power lines & tree limbs
- If you do lose power, remember **carbon monoxide is deadly**; use generators outdoors
- Standing water is a health hazard; contact should be avoided.
- Check yards for containers holding water and to dump the water to prevent mosquito from breeding
