Okaloosa County Water & Sewer Dept. Urges Residents to Protect Pipes in Cold Weather This Week

Okaloosa County will experience extremely cold temperatures on Monday night, January 4 and throughout the week. The Okaloosa County Water and Sewer Department urges residents to leave one faucet in their home or business running at a bare trickle overnight. Although there are no guarantees, keeping the water running at a trickle keeps the water moving in the service line and may prevent the line from freezing and bursting. Additionally, outdoor pipes can be wrapped in blankets, etc. to keep pipes warmer in cold temperatures. Frozen water services lines sometimes burst and then a plumber must be called for repairs.
