Hollywood Blvd. Resurfacing to Begin Monday, June 7th

Mary Esther, Fla. – Paving crews will begin mobilizing toward the end of this week in order to start the resurfacing work and final striping along **Hollywood Boulevard from Mary Esther Cutoff to Hill Avenue**. Asphalt paving is scheduled to take approximately three weeks to complete and will wrap up this much needed improvement project.

No closures or detours are planned until the final lift of asphalt is placed. However, motorist should be aware of lane shifts and expect some slight delays when traveling through the area. Please use caution and be reminded that the speed limit through the **Hollywood Boulevard work zone is still posted at 15 MPH**.
