Parks Advisory Committee Seeks Members

The Okaloosa County Park Advisory Committee is seeking (#) volunteer(s) member to serve on the committee. The Park Advisory Committee is comprised of nine citizens, six coming from the unincorporated areas and three from the incorporated, with each County Commission District being represented by at least one member. Committee members meet one morning a month, unless a special meeting is scheduled, and rotate locations between north and south Okaloosa County. Requirements and details are below:

- Members serve a three-year term.
- Member required must be a resident of one of the county's nine municipalities, preferably from area needing volunteer (insert).
- Parks Advisory Committee is comprised of nine citizens, six coming from the unincorporated areas and three from the incorporated, with each County Commission District being represented by at least one member.
- Purpose of the committee is to serve as advisors to the Board of County Commissioners and the Parks Department.
- Specific duties include identifying potential land opportunities for future community parks and recreational activities, identifying potential funding sources, developing community partnership for cost reductions and assisting in the development of neighborhood parks.
