## **Okaloosa County Public Works Update**

Severe rain resulted over eight inches of rain in northern areas of Okaloosa County on January 20<sup>th</sup>. Public Works had to close 20 roads. As of Wednesday, February 3, all remaining roads were opened; however, many more roads need extra maintenance in the coming weeks, and today more rain and floods are predicted. Also due to record flooding, Public Works/Mosquito Control wants to remind residents about standing water, and suggest dumping containers, as well as keeping gutters clean and flowing.

Maintenance is scheduled for the following roads, and Okaloosa County Public Works will provide updates on any roads close or storm water problems due to today's rain event. There is still storm water work to be done on Dairy Road, Old Bethel and Airport Road in the north and Mainsail in the south. Okaloosa County crew portion of Earl Campbell is complete, and Red Barrow Road still needs work. Cold Mix and resurfacing projects are ongoing.
