Political Signs are Considered Temporary Signs: Okaloosa County Temporary Sign Ordinance

Political signs are considered temporary signs; however, are subject to Okaloosa County ordinance 91-1. For residential areas, the ordinance states temporary signs shall be placed a minimum of ten (10) feet from the roadway or curb, and shall not exceed six (6) square feet in size. Additionally, signs must promptly be removed following a political or other event.
