**AGREEMENT**

**This Agreement by and between Gulf Coast Community College (hereinafter "GCCC") and Okaloosa County Emergency Medical Services (hereinafter "OCEMS").**

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS:**

- 1. GCCC is an accredited community college offering programs in Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic and other Allied Health Services and is required to offer its students clinical education as part of overall course curriculum, and
- 2. OCEMS is an emergency medical services provider licensed by the Florida Department of Health and Rehabilitative Services, willing to participate as a partner with GCCC in order to provide students with their clinical education experience;

NOW, THEREFORE, to assure the availability and quality of clinical education, the parties agree as follows:

**A. Responsibilities of GCCC**

- 1. GCCC has responsibility for scheduling of student assignments.
- 2. GCCC will provide qualified clinical instructors to supervise students from their staff when available.
- 3. If GCCC does not have staff available to serve as clinical instructors in any particular clinical program, GCCC will notify OCEMS of the need for clinical preceptors and OCEMS will cooperate with GCCC to identify qualified ambulance personnel to act as clinical preceptors. GCCC will provide OCEMS personnel with program and materials outlining what are expected of both clinical preceptors and students during their clinical education.
- 4. GCCC will require each student to carry professional liability insurance in an amount of not less than \$1,000,000 each claim and \$3,000,000 maximum aggregate, and shall furnish a certificate of such insurance upon request.
- 5. GCCC agrees that OCEMS is not obligated to provide free medical care to any GCCC student because of any injury or illness arising out of this agreement.

**B. RESPONSIBILITIES OF OCEMS**

1. OCEMS agrees to make available to GCCC its clinical facilities and vehicles for the training of paramedic students.
2. OCEMS will provide adequate instructional space for conducting student conferences and classes, when necessary.
3. OCEMS will provide, if requested by GCCC, qualified clinical preceptors in specific clinical areas in which students will be receiving their clinical education.
4. OCEMS will allow GCCC staff and students use of all reference material available at OCEMS.

**C. TERM**

1. The term of this agreement will be for an indefinite period beginning with the signing date of this agreement.

**D. TERMINATION**

1. This agreement may be terminated at any time by either party giving thirty (30) days written notice.
2. In the event of termination, it is agreed that such termination will not effect those students who are then currently enrolled and covered by this agreement, or the obligation of GCCC to indemnify and hold OCEMS harmless.

**E. NOTICE**

1. All notices required under this agreement shall be sent by mail or by hand delivery to: GCCC in care of the President, 5230 West Highway 98, Panama City, Florida 32401, and to OCEMS in care of the Director of Emergency Medical Services, Courthouse Annex, 1250 North Eglin Parkway, Shalimar, Florida 32579.


