MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
96TH MEDICAL GROUP, EGLIN AIR FORCE BASE, FLORIDA
AND
OKALOOSA COUNTY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

Okaloosa County, as a political subdivision of the State of Florida, has a department of Emergency Medical Services (EMS). This department is staffed by highly skilled Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics, capable of providing Advanced Life Support (ALS). Okaloosa County EMS is licensed by the State of Florida as such a provider.

96th Medical Group, which lies with the borders of Okaloosa County, regularly provides emergency medical services to its staff and visitors on Eglin Air Force Base and its surrounding properties. From time to time, Okaloosa County EMS may need assistance from the 96th Medical Group to cover unusually high demands for emergency 911 services or for a disaster which occurs off of base property.

Effective 1 August 1998, and with concurrence of the Okaloosa County Board of County Commissioners (BCC), the 96th Medical Group will provide mutual aid assistance to Okaloosa County EMS as needed. All assistance provided by the 96th Medical Group would be provided when Eglin has the resources available to provide service.

The 96th Medical Group medical personnel will provide the same high level of care as any other person requiring their services while on Eglin Air Force Base property and with the same rate structure. Transportation destination will be determined by the medical personnel on scene, based on the patient's condition after consultation with the EMS base station or accepting physician. Whenever possible, the patient shall be transported to the closest hospital.


All requests for assistance from the 96th Medical Group will be made to the Eglin hospital's direct line from Okaloosa County's EMS Dispatch Center. Okaloosa County Dispatch will specify the resources needed, patient condition and call location. Once the unit is en route, communications will be maintained through the portable radio that has been provided to the 96th Medical Group. The responding unit will notify Okaloosa County Dispatch when they are en route, on scene, general patient condition, need for additional resources, en route to hospital, arrival at hospital and/or when the unit has completed the assignment.

In exchange for the 96th Medical Group providing mutual aid assistance to Okaloosa County, Okaloosa County EMS agrees to provide assistance when requested by 96th Medical Group. Okaloosa County EMS agrees to provide the same high level of care as

any other person requiring their services in Okaloosa County and at the same rate structure.

Each party waives all claims against the other party for compensation for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a consequence of the performance of this agreement.

This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party upon thirty days written notice to the other party.
