

Rules of Engagement

General Comments

- * 60-day window for accepting project proposals:
 - * Opens: March 9, 2015 (Day “0”)
 - * Closes: May 8, 2015 @ midnight
- * Part A and Part B will be available for submission
- * Part C provided for information only
- * Consultant reviews proposals and provides comments

Rules of Engagement

Small Projects (under \$90,000)

- * “Small” projects set-aside approximately \$960,000 (15% of \$6.4M Transocean settlement)
- * Consultants compile and review proposals
- * ORAC receives proposals with consultant comments
- * Presentation cut line will be at approximately \$1.92M (2 times the set-aside amount)
- * Proposers will have 10 minute presentation opportunity; ORAC has no time limit for Q&A
- * ORAC qualitatively scores in “Open Meeting”
- * No discussion / debate between ORAC members

Rules of Engagement

Large Projects (over \$90,000)

- * Consultants compile and review proposals
- * ORAC receives proposals with consultant comments
- * ORAC qualitatively scores Part A in “Open Meeting”
- * ORAC Part A scores added to model derived Part B scores
- * Presentation cut line will be at approximately \$10.88M
- * Proposers will have 10 minute presentation opportunity; ORAC has no time limit for Q&A
- * ORAC will finalize scores in “Open Meeting”
- * No discussion / debate between ORAC members

Rules of Engagement

General Comments Post ORAC

- * ORAC submit recommended Multi-Year Implementation Plan (MYIP) to Board of County Commissioners (BOCC)
- * BOCC submit draft MYIP to Treasury
- * Once Treasury approves MYIP, County notifies successful proposers
- * Proposer (with assistance from County) completes Part C for MYIP projects
