- 1. What is the contract term date? It will be updated to be for one (1) year from when all parties have signed with the option of four (4) one (1) year renewals.
- 2. Does the County plan on purchasing the equipment from the contractor? Yes, if the budget will allow.
- 3. Would the County be open to outsourcing the maintenance and monitoring? Yes, it would be an option to the County.

- 4. How does the County plan on monitoring the data? County staff will monitor data collection. The data will need to be sent to a computer which will be located at the Visitor's Center in Okaloosa Island. The Contractor will need to work with the department and the internal IT department to make sure things are running smoothly.
- 5. Under #3 of the Evaluation Criteria, it lists how the contractor should respond with respect to the pricing. Can you please explain what all needs to be included? The contractor should include their hourly rate as well as the cost of the equipment, overhead, and any installation or outside costs that might need to be included to give the County the total price for all work to be done.
- 6. What is the total budgeted amount for this project? The estimated budget amount for this project is \$300,000.
